

About the program

4 islands in 7 days and a carefully—designed international program

The program takes place on various sites along the coast and the islands during the day. Each day will be an opportunity to explore a different sight, island and secluded beach where students will work on their assignments and projects.

Each activity will be followed by evaluation, self-evaluation and individual and group feedback

In the evening, participants will explore the rich night life offered by top world destinations in the peak of the Croatian tourist season.



There will be four teams of students. Each day, teams will be given a Daily Team Assignment that they will have to fulfill. These

assignments will address their leadership and teamwork skills. Each team will have to fulfill a task during the program.

Mentoring

The team tasks will include topics from business, ecology, and tourism/hospitality management. All projects will focus on student exploration of the area visited during the program (all the islands). Students will have mentors and guides to help them.







The Stinerary



Students arrive in Marina Trogir. The departure from the Marine is on July 9, 2016 between 4 pm and 6 pm. The nearest airport to Trogir is the Split airport. However, the airport in Zadar is not far away and the airport in Zagreb also has very good connections and a bus line that goes to Split frequently during the summer.

In Trogir, students are divided into two groups and embark two separate sailboats where they are further divided into two groups on each sailboat (total of four groups) and situated in cabins. Throughout 7 days, the students will sail the following route:

TROGIR – SESULA (ISLAND OF SOLTA) – HVAR (ISLAND OF HVAR) – KOMIŽA (ISLAND OF VIS) – VIS (ISLAND OF VIS) – STARI GRAD (ISLAND OF HVAR) – BOL (ISLAND OF BRAC) SPLIT*

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Health Issues - participants must deliver a doctor's note confirming their health is in good condition and they can embark the sailboat


English Proficiency - the program will be conducted completely in English, so students should have at least a B2 level proficiency (according to the European CEFR)
